Developing Step-by-Step Instructions

The key to writing instructions is simplicity. Rather than paragraphs, use bullet points or numbered steps and visuals.

Consider the following guidelines:

- Use short, concise phrases or sentences.
- Use active, descriptive words.
- Be consistent in your use of words and type styles. Use bold, italic, and color for emphasis, yet don't over use these elements.

Unit Vocabulary-Make sure to use all of the vocabulary to show understanding of each term

- Canvas
- Transparent
- Gradient Mode/Fill
- Linear Gradient
- Radial Gradient
- Pencil Edge
- Shape tools-Ellipse tool, Rectangle tool, Smart polygon tool, Line tool

Visuals

Visuals are an important part of any set of instructions. Screenshots are a good idea for demonstrating the relationships and events in the software.

In order to receive full credit for this assignment you must add at least 3 screen shots

Step 1	Create a new MS Word document
Step 2	Add a title and your image center aligned (Insert picture from file, do not screenshot your cartoon picture)
Step 3	Type out your directions one step at a time
Step 4	Add images as needed-(at least 3 screen shots required)
Step 5	Save as ### last name, first name-Tutorial
Step 6	Save again as a PDF and drop off only the PDF
