

PHOTO 1 REMOTE LEARNING ASSIGNMENT #A: EXPLORING A SUBJECT (100 PHOTOS)

(HAND IN VIA GOOGLE DRIVE)

Creativity and skill sharpening exercise: choose a simple object and take at least a hundred shots of it, **then upload the pictures to your Google Drive and "Share" them with me.**

Each picture of this simple object must be from a different perspective

Explore the effects of light and shadow.

Experiment with focus, points of view, or an unsteady camera.

Try different types of light (*on camera flash / sunlight / dish light / flashlight / soft light / harsh light / reflected / bounced light etc.*)

Try different types of backgrounds or environments

Follow the "Rule of Thirds" (if you don't know what "Rule of Third" means, look it up!)

HOW TO HAND THIS ASSIGNMENT IN...

- 1] CREATE A FOLDER IN YOUR GOOGLE DRIVE
- 2] LABEL IT WITH YOUR NAME, HOUR, AND THE ASSIGNMENT NAME (100)
- 4] UPLOAD YOUR 100 PHOTOS IN THAT FOLDER
- 3] SHARE IT WITH ME

NOTE:

- If you have issues uploading 100 pictures at one time (*usually happens if you are uploading on your phone rather than a desktop computer*), try loading the pictures in batches...like maybe 10 at a time.
- If you do not know how to upload your pictures from your phone to your Google Drive, create a folder, or share with me...go to your course in iLearn and look for the Topic "How To...". Click on it and look for the document titled "Google Drive".

GOOD EXAMPLE (*Why is it a good example???*)

- The surface that it has been placed on works well with the object rather than competing with it
- There is nothing in the background that distracts your focus from the object
- The light falls softly across the object, drawing the viewer's eye towards the object
- The object is in focus
- The object has been placed in a lower corner (See Rule of Thirds)



BAD EXAMPLE (*Why is it a bad example???*)



- Picture needs to be cropped to get rid of the mouse pad and the lamp
- Other objects distract the viewer from focusing on the featured object
- Camera is placed too far away, making the other items just as important looking as the featured object

4 x 100 pictures = 4 points
