<u>Course Description:</u> Students will learn to become stronger readers, writers, speakers, and listeners this year. We will read different genres and practice writing in those genres. We will study how great authors write and incorporate their skills into our own. Students must be open to creating new ideas and respectful of others' ideas.

We will use the "Daily 5" framework to give students freedom and responsibility to work on assignments of their own choice each week. This will be used along with whole class instruction on reading for comprehension, accuracy, fluency, and to expand vocabulary. Students will be assigned homework daily, even if it is only to read for 20 minutes. Please check the blog to stay up to date on assignments.

Classroom Rules and Expectations:

- 1. Be in your seat, with your materials, ready to start when it is time for class, or you will be marked tardy.
- 2. Bring your planner, pencils/pens, chosen reading book, binder, and any homework.
- 3. Listen carefully and follow directions the first time they are given.
- 4. Raise your hand and wait to be called on before speaking.
- 5. Respect others. Be kind with your words and actions.
- 6. Respect things that belong to your school, your classmates, and your teachers.

Failure to comply with the classroom expectations will result in:

- -Student being sent to Responsibility Room to reflect on how behavior affects others.
- -Parent notification (via phone or email).
- -After School Detention (if missed for any reason, will become 2 detentions).
- -Restorative Hours spent working in Mr. Melvin's class or around the building.
- -Extreme cases will result in a behavioral referral being sent to the Assistant Principal,
- and a conference may be scheduled with parent, teacher(s), and student.

<u>Planner:</u> Planners need to be with students at all times. You will be given one planner for free at the beginning of the school year. If you lose your planner, you **must purchase another one in the office for \$5.00.** Students will be responsible for recording class activities and homework at the end of class each day. Also, if you need to leave the room to go to your locker, the office, or the bathroom, you must have your planner to do so. **No Planner = No Pass.** Each student gets 5 passes per marking period.

<u>Homework</u>: Homework will be posted on the blog. Homework is to be turned in the following day, unless otherwise directed. Homework must be completed neatly and thoroughly by the *beginning* of class to receive full credit. Poor quality is not accepted under any circumstances. Late work will be subject to a 20% penalty. Work without a student's name/correct heading will be subject to a 10% penalty.

<u>Absences:</u> When students are absent, they are responsible for checking the calendar/blog, getting their assignments from the green "Extra Copies" folder, and turning them in. If a student is absent on the day an assignment is due, he or she should plan to turn it in the day he or she returns to school. If you know you will be absent in advance, please let Mr. Melvin know and he can get assignments ready so no work is missed.

Projects: Students will be expected to complete projects and essays independently, as well as in groups. Students will be given some class time to work on projects, but please plan to work on them at home as well. Turning in the same writing or exact same project as another student will be considered **plagiarism**, and will result in a zero for the assignment, as well as having to redo the assignment.

Grading Procedures: Students' grades are based on points earned on tasks completed in and out of class. The points are added together for the final marking period grade. Assignments like in-class work, homework, rough drafts, and grammar practice are considered formative (they help form knowledge) and count for 20% of students' overall grades. Quizzes, tests, projects, and essays are considered summative and count for 80% of students' overall grades. This is a policy across Stout Middle School. Students will take notes every two weeks, and will be tested on the information in those notes every other Friday. Plan to study for tests, as mastery of these skills is expected. If students are absent on the day of a test or quiz, they are to make it up the day they return to school. Quizzes may be unannounced.
