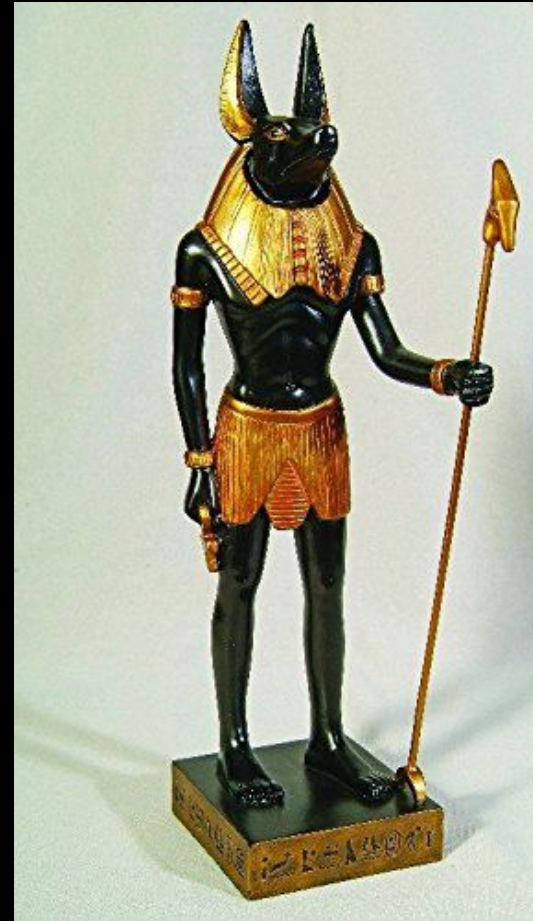

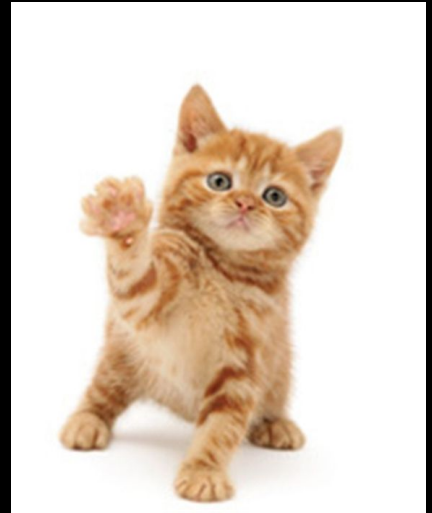

8.3 Pharaoh Khufu: The Pyramid Builder

- The pharaoh Khufu ruled during the Old Kingdom.
 - Today Khufu is known as the builder of the famous pyramid.
- Khufu emphasized his supreme power by declaring himself a god.
- He kept strict control over Egypt's food supply.
- Khufu and other pharaohs during the Old Kingdom built pyramids as tombs for themselves and their families.
- The Great Pyramid of Giza was made with over 2 million stone blocks that fit together perfectly.
 - Inside, tunnels led to several burial chambers.
 - It took over 20 years to complete.
 - It is the only remaining wonder of the ancient world.
 - The pyramid was a stunning monument to Egyptian engineering.

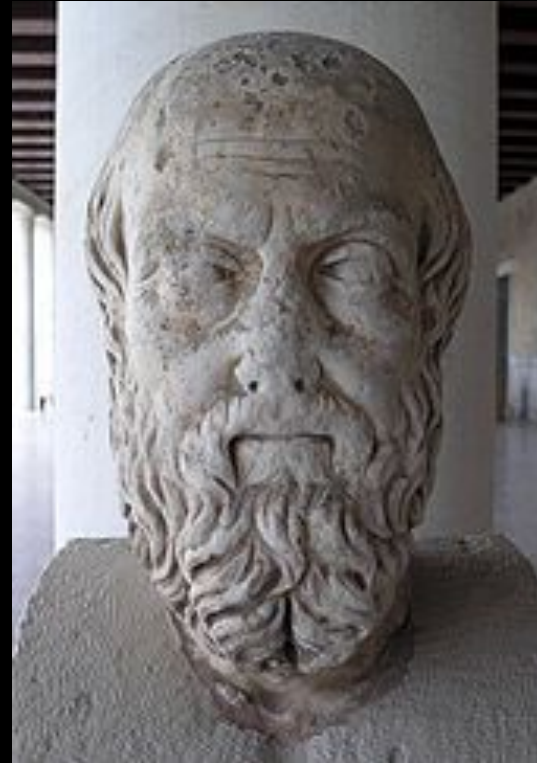
