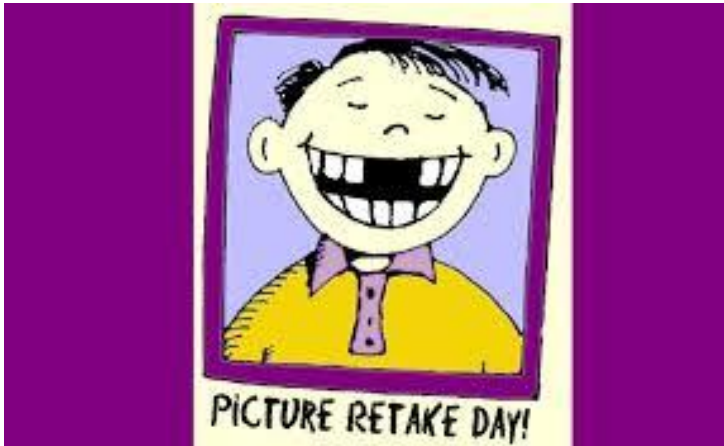

The Student Council will have its first meeting next week on Wednesday, October 7th from 3 - 5 pm in G-3, Mrs. Woolley's room.

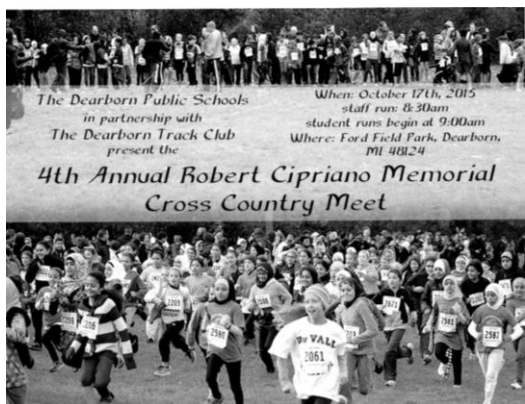
