Interested students should submit:

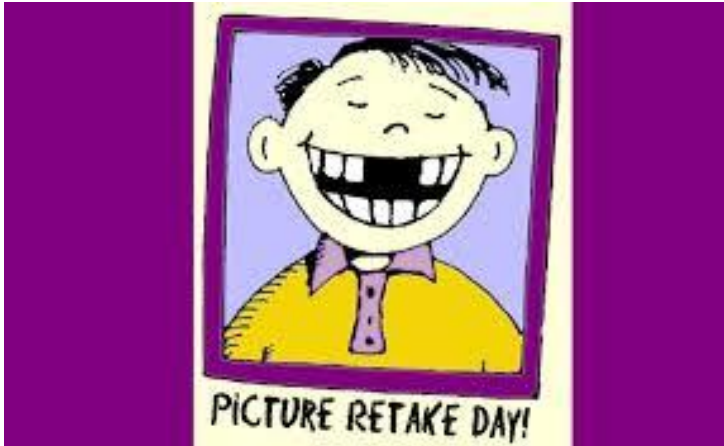
- First and last name
