NOTICE THINKING

TYPES OF QUESTIONS YOUR COMMENTS MIGHT ANSWER:

- What are you thinking about as you "read" this text?
- What is your mind telling you while you are "reading" this text?
 - What did you notice about this text?

TYPES OF COMMENTS YOU MIGHT MAKE:

- I can't concentrate.
- This is frustrating me.

FOCUS ON READING

TYPES OF QUESTIONS YOUR COMMENTS MIGHT ANSWER:

- Where did you begin to get confused?
- Was there a particular word/sentence that got in your way?
 - What was hard about keeping straight what you read?

TYPES OF COMMENTS YOU MIGHT MAKE:

- Where did this character come from?
- Too much new information here!

FOCUS ON SOLVING READING PROBLEMS

TYPES OF QUESTIONS YOUR COMMENTS MIGHT ANSWER:

- What connections did you make?
 - How did you figure that out?
- How could you get an overview of what this section says?

 TYPES OF COMMENTS YOU MIGHT MAKE:
- This transition word shows the section might have key ideas.
 - I need to figure out what this is saying. I'll chunk it.

FOCUS ON DISCIPLINARY LITERACY PRACTICES

TYPES OF QUESTIONS YOUR COMMENTS MIGHT ANSWER:

- How does the author use languge to establish a particular tone?
 - What pattern are you seeing?
 - What does the evidence lead you to predict?
 TYPES OF COMMENTS YOU MIGHT MAKE:
 - This part of the passage is irrelevant to the task.
 - This point of view is not trustworthy.
