

# Multiplying 0.00

## STEPS:

- Multiply
- Add if there is more than one place value.
- Count how many decimal place values there is.
- Move the decimal that many times, starting from the left.

## Examples:

$$\begin{array}{r} 49.2 \\ \times 0.3 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 6.5 \\ \times 6.5 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1960 \\ \times 60 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 11520 \\ \times 20 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 12480 \\ \times 0 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

# Adding 0.00

## STEPS:

- Write 7.943 and 11.220.
- Line up Decimals.
- Add them together.
- Check your work.

## Examples:

$$\begin{array}{r} 7.943 \\ + 1.122 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1.122 \\ + 1.122 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1.943 \\ + 1.122 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

# Subtracting 0.00

## STEPS:

- Line up the decimals.
- Subtract
- Bring down the decimal to the answer.

## TIP:

- You may have to add 0's

## Examples:

$$\begin{array}{r} 84.5 \\ - 32.15 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 81.395 \\ - 32.15 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
