
Story Banner

The Story Banner helps kids identify significant story objects when giving a book-talk.



Materials:

Coat hanger Craft paper Paint or markers Glue Paper/pencil Glitter

Goal:

To create a banner that uses symbols to represent important story events.

Steps:

- 1. Think through the story you have selected and make a list of five important story events. Choose an object (symbol) to represent each event. The clues in the mystery
- 2. Draw a draft of your banner on paper.
- 3. Cut craft paper to fit the width of a hanger.
- 4. Fold the paper through the hanger and glue the overlap to the back of the sheet as shown in step 4.
- 5. Create your banner with paint or markers.
- 6. Hang your story banner and retell the story to friends.
- 7. Include on the banner the title of the story, author, and your name.
- 8. Write a description for each object and describe how it was important to solving the mystery. Be prepared to retell your story using the banner.
