

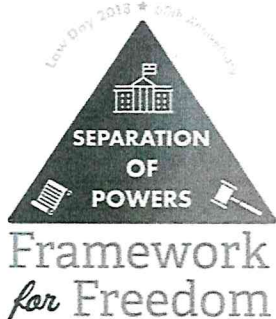

THE 19<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT COURT CELEBRATES LAW DAY 2018

The 2018 theme is ***Separation of Powers: Framework for Freedom***. The U.S. Constitution sets out a system of government with distinct and independent branches—Congress, the Presidency, and a Supreme Court. It also defines legislative, executive, and judicial powers and outlines how they interact. These three separate branches share power, and each branch serves as a check on the power of the others. The Law Day 2018 theme enables us to reflect on the separation of powers as fundamental to our constitutional purpose and to consider how our governmental system is working for ourselves and our posterity.

**ESSAY QUESTION:** Describe some of the powers each branch of government has. Explain the benefits of assigning different powers to separate branches of our government and how the three branches check on each other's powers? In your opinion what is the most powerful branch of government and why?

Your 19<sup>th</sup> District Court has long been an active participant in the American Bar Association's National Law Day observance. All award recipients and their families will be invited to an awards ceremony at the Courthouse **on Thursday, May 10, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. First place winners will get to read their essay to the audience.** The 19<sup>th</sup> District Court will host refreshments at the conclusion of the program.
