## **Summer Learning Book Talk Directions**

Choose one of the three to five books you read over the summer to present as a book talk in your 6th Grade Language Arts class. Use an 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> x11 or a 9x12 piece of paper for your presentation.

## Front of the Paper

- 1. Create a visual representation of the book. This could be a picture of the setting, the characters, or your favorite event in the story.
- 2. Include the title and author of your book.

## **Back of the Paper**

- 1. Write a complete summary of your book. Be sure to include specific and important details about the events in the story including how the story ends.
- 2. Write down your favorite passage and the pages it came from. Be sure to have a sticky note while you read so you can easily find your favorite part again and use it for this book talk.
- 3. Would you recommend this book to a classmate? Evaluate what is good/bad about the book using some specific details about the plot, characters, problem, and solution of your novel.
