VIRTUAL LEARNING EXPECTATIONS

Student Expectations for Online Learning

- Students should check their virtual classrooms each day for assignments.
- Students should communicate issues with connectivity, online access, or hardware immediately.
- Students should be aware that the teacher work day is from 8:00 a.m. until 3:15 p.m. each day.
- Students should make a habit of shutting down and restarting each computer/device at least once a week, even once a day, to optimize performance.
- Make sure that the computer/chromebook is completely charged before class sessions.
- You must be on time and ready to participate in each class.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR ON ZOOM

- Students should enter meetings in mute mode.
- No Chatting unless asking the teacher a question.
- Remember that Chat is public; everyone can see what you write!
- Students should try to log online to each class meeting from a quiet, distraction-free environment.
- Students should try to log online to each class meeting from a place with a background that they would not mind others seeing.
- Students should enable video so that the teacher can see them and their other classmates.
- Students should sit quietly with their devices with no walking or moving around while in a meeting.
- Students should not eat while in online meetings.
- Come prepared with all of your social studies material
- Students are expected to display appropriate classroom behavior in all virtual classrooms.

• Students should make sure to log out of video sessions.
