

Week 11 - 5th Grade Spelling Words

Multisyllabic words – ou, ow, oi, oy

Explanation:

Oi or Oy: Generally, use *oi* in the middle of a word and use *oy* at the end of a word. Examples: boil, soil, toil, boy, toy.

Ou or Ow: Generally use *ou* in the middle of a word and use *ow* at the end of words other than those that end in *n* or *d*. Examples: mouse, house, found, mount, borrow, row, throw, crow.
