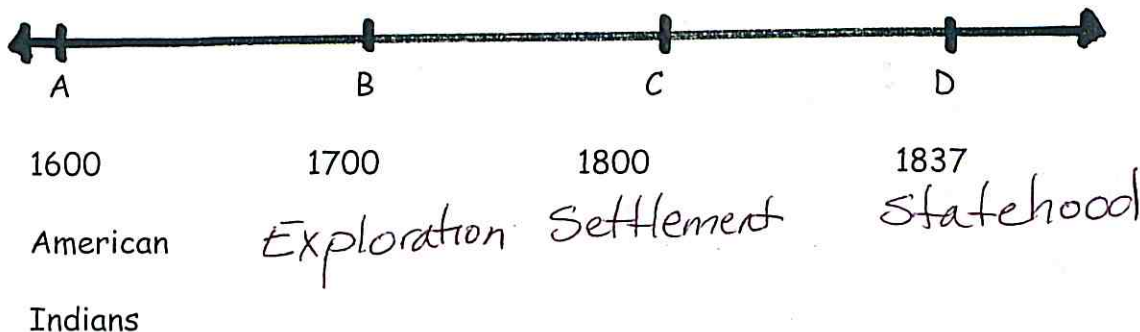
14. Name a challenge that early settlers in MI faced?
