WHAT TO DO IN A LOCKDOWN DRILL


It is important to know what to do when there is an emergency at school. We know what to do when we hear the fire alarm, but do we know what to do when it is time for a lockdown drill?



We have lockdown drills to practice what we would do if there was a dangerous person or situation inside or outside of our school. It is important to know what to do so we can keep ourselves and others safe.



During a lock down drill we will hear an announcement that says "This is a lock down drill". We know that it is **only practice** when the announcement says the word "drill". That means that we are not in danger and that it is only for practice.




When we hear the announcement, we will behave like we would in a real lockdown by...

- Going calmly and quietly to our safe place in the classroom
- Listening to all teacher directions
- Sitting still with no talking. It is important to stay quiet.
- Waiting for an announcement that the lock down drill is over
