Dear Parents & Students,

Welcome to the beginning of a new semester!

As your child's mathematics teachers, we would like to let you know how much we are looking forward to working with both you and your son or daughter. The beginning of the school year is always an exciting and busy time, but we would appreciate it if you would take a few minutes to review the information here.

In Algebra 2B, students will work with several types of functions (linear, quadratic, polynomial, logarithmic, and trigonometric). Students will work on sine, cosine, and tangent functions and their translations. They will also learn how to work on solving trigonometric equations using inverses and they will learn how to use the law of sine and cosines.

**BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS**

- \*Students will be expected to take notes and participate in all classroom activities.
- \*Students will be expected to treat every student and the teacher with respect.
- \*Independent work time must be used to complete the assignment.

**HOMEWORK, CLASSWORK, AND BELLWORK**

Most of the assignments will be completed as classwork and due at the end of the hour, but will become homework, at our discretion, if time is limited. The following guidelines should be followed in order to receive full credit (each assignment is worth 4 points).

- \*You must show work. No Work = No Credit**
- \*You must show effort and try your best.
- \*Homework, classwork and bellwork assignments should be done neatly and they should be readable.
- \*Incomplete assignments will lose credit.
- \*Your name, hour, and date should be written on the upper right hand of the page.
- \*Use pencil.

There will be a bellwork assignment at the beginning of the hour. This work should be finished on a separate sheet of paper and it should be corrected as we go over it. The bellwork will be collected on Fridays. Missing assignments (in case of an absence) should be completed one day after the student returns to class.
