

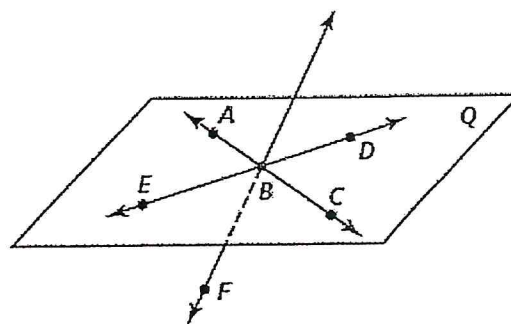
Practice 1-3 **Points, Lines, and Planes**
