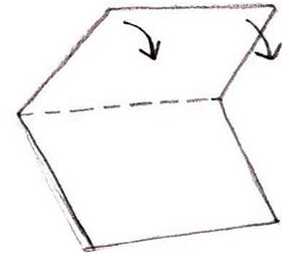


Vocabulary Booklets
