
Let's Compare Lists...


- Whip around! Tallest person in the room starts!

- Write the name of your industry in the middle diamond.






Trace the folds to make them stand out!


Box One

Box 2

Two of your team members need to play rock-paper-scissors. The winner decides which of them writes next.

Title the upper right box **JOBS**, and work together to write a list of all the jobs you can think of related to your industry. Really stretch on this one!

Box 3

- The person with the most siblings writes next.
- Write a T chart in the bottom left box and title it **BEFORE** and **WITHOUT**.
- Brainstorm to come up with as many ideas as you can about what we did **BEFORE** this industry, and what we would do if zombies or aliens came and it all went away. Use bullet points.



Box 4

- If you haven't written yet, it is your turn! If there are more than one of you left, flip a coin, winner decides which of you writes.
- Label the last box **FUTURE**. Now brainstorm to come up with ideas as to what is next for your industry, what does the future hold?
