

Questioning

- Thin questions: typically asked to clarify confusion, define words, or can be answered with an objective answer. Often begin with “Who”, “What”, “Where”, “When”? “How many”?
 - *Who is Dr. Strauss?*
 - *What does “Rorschach” mean?*
 - *Where is Charlie staying when he is being observed by the scientists?*
- Thick question: identify large questions, are probably subject to debate and may not have one right answer. Begin with “Why”, “How come”, “I wonder?”
 - *Why did Charlie agree to the operation?*
 - *I wonder why Dr. Strauss and Dr. Nemur thought Charlie would be a good candidate for the operation?*
 - *How come Charlie never noticed before how beautiful Ms. Kinnian is?*
 - *Is it right to perform this type of experiment on someone?*
- Tip: Read with questions in mind.
