### Directions:

1. Find an activist (either historical or current) who uses the principles of non-violent resistance in their protests. It can be an individual person, or a group of people acting together. **YOU MAY NOT CHOOSE HENRY DAVID THOREAU, MOHANDAS GANDHI, MARTIN LUTHER KING JR, THE FRIENDSHIP 9 OR THE GREENSBORO 4.**
2. Research this activist on the web.
3. Find **ONE RELIABLE** source on the internet that explains your activist and his/her protest. Wikipedia **IS NOT** a reliable source.
4. There will be an assignment posted in google classroom, with a link to a survey. You will answer the questions on the survey using the information you found during your research.
5. You will create another "non-violent protestor" tree map with evidence about your activist. Bring this to class with you.

### Tips and hints:

Choose someone that interests you.

Don't tell anyone else who you chose. This will make your life easier in the long run.

There will be other assignments that go along with this, so choose your person wisely. Once you fill out, your survey, your choice is set in stone.
