I print out one set of cards and use book rings to create several portable sets. These quick question card rings are on-the-go as much as our students are!

Although RIT bands 135–200 for reading are represented, I also included extra cards that all of our students learn (i.e.: I included the entire alphabet for initial consonants and letter identification, plus compound word cards).

There are also several skills that appear at different RIT bands.

When this occurred, I recorded the lower RIT range.

I would rather have my students more prepared, than less!

Here's a MEGA set of quick question cards based on NWEA MAP Testing RIT Bands 135–200!

Our school participates in NWEA MAP Testing three times per year (Fall baseline, then Winter and Spring growth). Based on national norms, students enter first grade in the mid 150's for Math and Reading and grow to late 170's by spring. Although those number are the national averages, a student may experience test questions at higher/lower RIT band levels at various times during the computerized assessment.

Your school doesn't participate in NWEA Map Testing?

No problem! The entire test is aligned with Common

Core State Standards.

These cards would be helpful to activate prior knowledge at the beginning of a lesson, as a check for understanding during guided practice, and as an exit ticket follow-up.

I also repeat cards for spiral review...they are used with student teachers and/or volunteers, during hallway transitions...

I use them everywhere!
