Terminology

Meaning

arthralgia otalgia neuralgia

Pain in a joint.
Pain in the ear.
Pain of nerves.

myalgia rectocele

Pain of muscles.

Hernia of the rectum.

cystocele thoracentesis Hernia of the urinary bladder.

Surgical puncture to remove fluid from the chest.

amniocentesis abdominocentesis

Surgical puncture of the amnion.
Surgical puncture of the abdomen.

streptococcus

Berry-shaped (spheroidal) bacterium found in twisted chains.

staphylococci

Berry-shaped (spheroidal) bacteria in clusters.

erythrocyte leukocyte thrombocyte

Red blood cell.
White blood cell.
Clotting cell.

pleurodynia

Pain in the chest wall muscles that is aggravated by breathing (literally: pain of

the pleura).

laryngectomy mastectomy Removal of the larynx. Removal of a breast.

anemia ischemia

Decrease in erythrocytes or hemoglobin. To hold back blood from an area of the body.

carcinogenesis pathogenesis angiogenesis Condition of producing cancer.
Condition of producing disease.
Formation of blood vessels.

electroencephalogram myelitis

Record of the electricity in the brain.
Inflammation of the spinal cord.
Record (x-ray) of the breast.

mammogram electroencephalograph

electroencephalography

Instrument for recording the electricity in the brain.

Process of recording the electricity in the brain.

Process of recording (x-ray imaging) blood vessels.

bronchitis tonsillitis

angiography

Inflammation of the bronchi.
Inflammation of the tonsils.

thrombophlebitis

Inflammation of a vein with clot formation.

ophthalmology morphology

Study of the eye.
Study of shape or form.

hemolysis

Destruction of blood (breakdown of red blood cells with release of hemoglobin).

osteomalacia chondromalacia

Softening of bone.
Softening of cartilage.

acromegaly splenomegaly

myoma

Enlargement of extremities. Enlargement of the spleen.

Tumor (benign) of muscle.
