- Unpleasant sensation from the stomach with tendency to vomit
- Gas expelled through the anus
- Lack of appetite
- Bright red fresh blood from the rectum
- Difficult, delayed elimination of feces

- Yellow-orange skin; icterus
- 3 Rumbling or gurgling noises produced by the movement of gas or fluid

- Twisting of the intestine upon itself
- Small benign growths protruding from the mucous membrane of the large bowel
- Telescoping of the intestines
- Solids and fluids return to the mouth from the stomach

- Gallbladder calculi
- Inflammation of the liver: viral etiology
- Chronic liver disease; etiology is often alcoholism and malnutrition
- Sore or lesion of the mucous membrane of the first part of the small intestine
- Abnormal tube-like passageway in the distal end of the alimentary tract
- Painful inflamed intestines; etiology is often bacterial
- Swollen, tortuous veins in the distal portion of the tube connecting the throat and stomach
- Inflammation of a gland behind the stomach; cysts may form
- Inflammation of small side pockets in the intestinal wall
- Chronic inflammation of the large bowel with open sores of mucous membrane
- Chronic inflammation of the intestinal tract (terminal ileum)
- Failure of peristalsis
 - Failure of the LES muscle to relax
- Inflammation of the mouth with open sores
- Tooth decay
