- 7 Gas expelled through the anus
- 1 Lack of appetite
- 8 Bright red fresh blood from the rectum
- 4 Difficult, delayed elimination of feces

- 9 Yellow-orange skin; icterus
- 3 Rumbling or gurgling noises produced by the movement of gas or fluid

- 6 Small benign growths protruding from the mucous membrane of the large bowel
- 16 Telescoping of the intestines
- 13 Solids and fluids return to the mouth from the stomach

- 4 Gallbladder calculi
- 14 Inflammation of the liver; viral etiology
- 5 Chronic liver disease; etiology is often alcoholism and malnutrition
- 10 Sore or lesion of the mucous membrane of the first part of the small intestine
- 2 Abnormal tube-like passageway in the distal end of the alimentary tract
- 11 Painful inflamed intestines; etiology is often bacterial
- 12 Swollen, tortuous veins in the distal portion of the tube connecting the throat and stomach
- 17 Inflammation of a gland behind the stomach; cysts may form
- 9 Inflammation of small side pockets in the intestinal wall
- 19 Chronic inflammation of the large bowel with open sores of mucous membrane
- 7 Chronic inflammation of the intestinal tract (terminal ileum)
- 15 Failure of peristalsis
- 1 Failure of the LES muscle to relax
- 3 Inflammation of the mouth with open sores
- 8 Tooth decay
