**ASAP** if you've lost credit due to E or audit. See Mr. Minor or your counselor this week. Classes begin September 17<sup>th</sup>.

**College Application Week is October 7-11.** Complete and submit online **applications** to 3 colleges by November 1. Some colleges waive the fee during CAW (Wayne State, EMU for example). If there is a fee, play online with credit card.

Send **Transcripts** via Parchment.com. FYI - Attendance is visible on transcripts sent to college. Log-in to Parchment and send yourself an updated transcript. Watch for reduced credit due to attendance (audit).

Send **SAT scores** electronically through your College Board account. Seniors who did not take the SAT last year will take it April 2020. Take on your own now. <https://www.collegeboard.org/> Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> (regular deadline is Oct. 3) and Dec. 7<sup>th</sup> (regular deadline is Nov. 8)

If you are using the **Common Application** (UM-AA), counselor sends the transcript & student sends the SAT score. Let your counselor, recommending teachers know ASAP - email "high school resume" to help with letters and scholarship consideration. We have a form. WSU: Easier to apply to online so don't use the common app (free app during CAW)

**October 23rd – University of Michigan-Dearborn onsite application** procedure: Apply online and schedule an appointment during CAW to meet with the admission representative. You will get an admission decision and possible scholarship offer during your appointment.

**FAFSA** **Free Application for Federal Student Aid** submission begins October 1 using the 2018 Income Tax Returns. Once Colleges have all of your information (Application, Transcripts, SAT scores, FAFSA) they will send a Student Aid Report. Compare them and decide where you will attend by May 1<sup>st</sup>.
