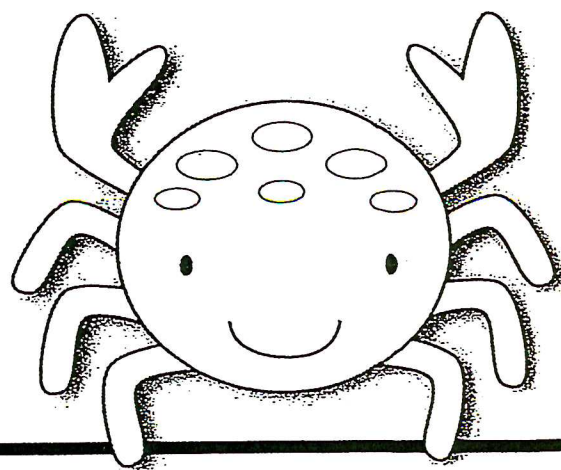


Crabs

Crabs can walk sideways. They can live on land. They can live in oceans. They can pinch. Ouch!



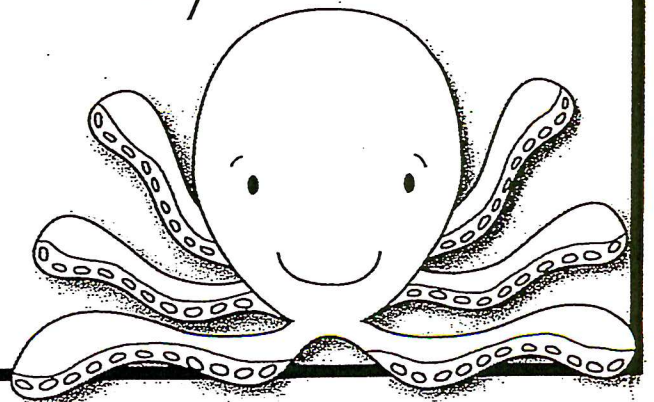
Octopuses

Octopuses can squirt ink. They can change colors. They can regrow lost arms.

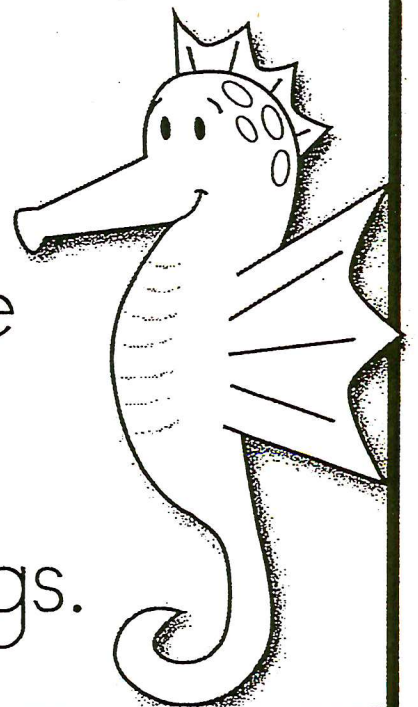


Sea Horses

upright. They can lay eggs.

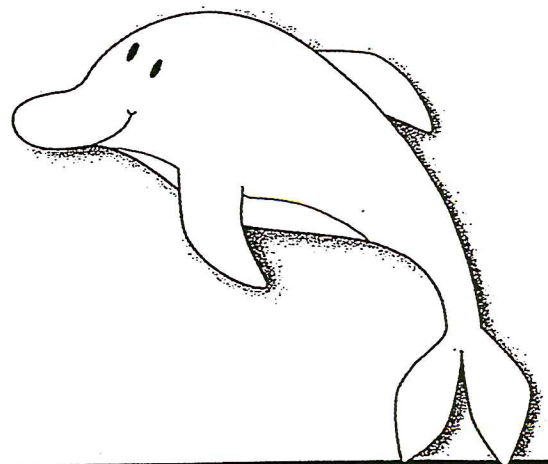


Dolphins

Dolphins can eat fish. They can live in pods. They can dive and jump.

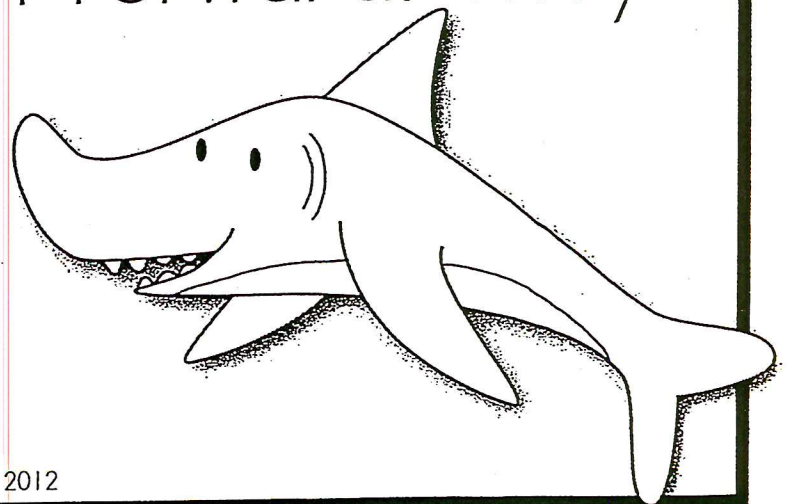


Sharks

Sharks can swim forward. They can glide. They can migrate.

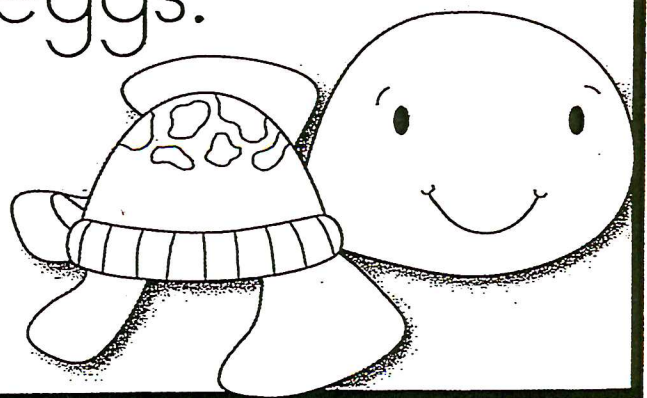


Sea Turtles

Sea Turtles can swim. They can dive. They can lay eggs. They can migrate.

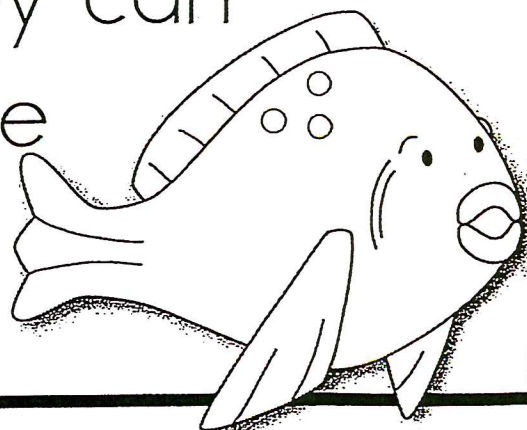


Fish
