Noun

A word that names a person, a place, a thing, or an idea Alex Moya Belize ladder courage

Pronoun

A word used in place of a noun

Verb

A word that shows action or links a subject to another word in the sentence

Adjective

A word that describes a noun or a pronoun stormy red rough seven grand

Adverb

A word that describes a verb, an adjective, or another adverb quickly today now bravely softer

Preposition

A word that shows position or direction and introduces a prepositional phrase

Conjunction

A word that connects other words or groups of words and but or so because when

Interjection

A word (set off by commas or an exclamation point) that shows strong emotion
