monkeys, and residents get trash cans with locks.

The city also hires guards to patrol certain areas. The guards scare off aggressive baboons using noisemakers and paintball guns.

Some animal rights groups have complained. They say the city is treating the baboons cruelly. But the city says it is helping the baboons. Animals that get food from humans often forget how to survive in the wild.

That doesn't seem to worry the baboons. They avoid the paintball guns by waiting just

outside the city. Then they dash in for five minutes, grab some food, and leave.

Scientists say baboons in the wild spend more than half their time looking for food.

The Cape Town baboons find what they need pretty quickly. That gives them plenty of free time to spend resting, grooming, fighting—and planning their next raid. •
