



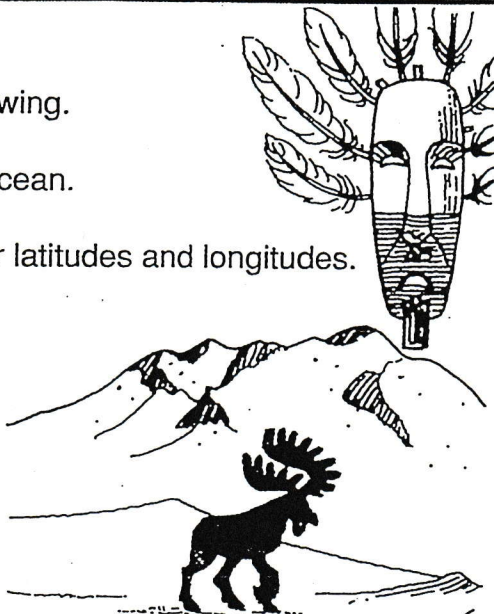

1. Label the Arctic Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, and Pacific Ocean.

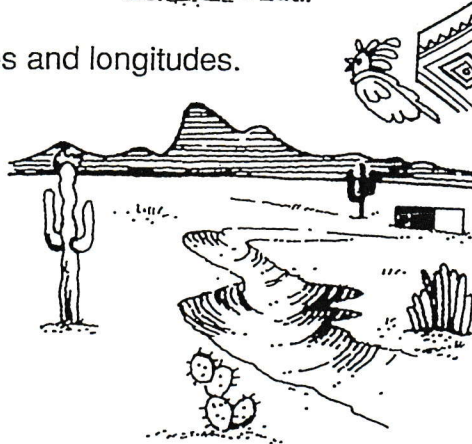
2. Label these bodies of water and match them with their latitudes and longitudes.

To sail from a city on the Gulf of Alaska to a city on the Gulf of St. Lawrence a ship would probably have to go south and southeast across the PACIFIC Ocean, through the PANAMA Canal, north across the CARIBBEAN Sea, between the islands of Cuba and HAITI, into the ATLANTIC Ocean, and then between the North American mainland and the island of NEWFOUNDLAND to reach its destination.
