

# One Pager Directions

A one pager is a way to visually share key ideas and information from what you have learned. When you create a one pager, you are trying to use both visual symbols and important words to clearly and concisely share your most important takeaways with someone else.

For your **TWO REQUIRED** one pagers, you must include the following:

- Your border will somehow represent the key topics and themes from the novel
- The upper left hand box will contain an important quote with a page number
  - The quote is significant to **YOU**. Maybe because it has **POWERFUL** language or is very descriptive
  - The quote is significant to you because you've made a **CONNECTION** to it
- The upper right hand box will contain at least **THREE** character traits of your protagonist with a hand-drawn picture of your protagonist
- The long middle box will include:
  - Novel's title (properly formatted)
  - Author of novel
  - Your name
- The large bottom box will include a **VISUAL** that focuses on the protagonist from the text and how they've developed from the beginning of the novel to the end.
  - Must include two hand drawn representations of the character (beginning and end)
  - Must include two **QUOTES WITH PAGE NUMBERS**
    - Quotes can provide a physical description of the character
    - Or quote can be your favorite line/lines the character says
- You may also add other symbols, drawings, and words that represent the reading as you wish
