If your answer is a different answer—>	"Where's my cheese?"




Question #3: What did you learn how to do this summer?

If your answer is 636.66 —>	put a girl and a boy on the back of your postcard
If your answer is a different answer—>	put a clown on the back of your postcard



Question #4: What did you do on your summer vacation?

I played non-stop	$18.52 \times 7 =$
we went on a trip	$16.23 \times 9 =$

What is your answer? On the back of your post-card...

If your answer is 129.64 —>	put a jump rope and different toys
If your answer is 137.68 —>	put a swimming pool
If your answer is 146.07 —>	draw the place you went on your trip
If your answer is neither of those —>	put a big chocolate covered donut

Question #5: How many books did you read this summer?

Eek, was I supposed to read?	$84.54 - 69.77 =$
I read between 1 and 5 books	$95.78 - 78.89 =$
I read over 5 books	$82.43 - 67.76 =$

What is your answer? On the back of your post card...

If your answer is 14.67 —>	put the amount of books that your read on your postcard
If your answer is 14.77 —>	put a big question mark on your postcard
If your answer is 16.89 —>	put a single book on your postcard
If your answer is a different answer —>	put a big hairy foot on your postcard

Question #6: What did you eat this summer?

ice cream, ice cream and more ice cream	$12.75 \times 18 =$
popsicles and anything cold	$13.64 \times 17 =$
broccoli and vegetables	$12.68 \times 16 =$

What is your answer? On the back of your post card...

If your answer is 229.5 —>	put a ice cream cone on the right side of your postcard
If your answer is 202.88 —>	put cauliflower on the left side of your postcard
If your answer is 231.88 —>	put popsicles on the right side of your postcard
If your answer is a different answer—>	put a puppy dog print on the left side of your post-card

Question #7: What is the single best thing about summer?

coming back to school at the end	$14.044 - 8.776 =$
lots of free-time	$13.075 - 8.921 =$
everything!	$12.167 - 9.385 =$

What is your answer? Turn your postcard to the front.

If your answer is 5.268 —>	write the letter of your postcard in blue ink
If your answer is 2.782 —>	write the letter of your postcard in black ink
If your answer is 4.154 —>	write the letter of your postcard in green ink
If you put something else inside the circle —>	write the letter of your postcard in multiple colors

What is your answer?


If your answer is 119 —>	address your postcard to your best friend

If your answer is a different answer—>	your elbow




Question #10: What was your favorite subject this year?

lunch and recess!	11.973 - 4.295 =


What is your answer? Close your letter by...
