

Scholarships #7 – January 28, 2021

1. **University of Michigan Alumni Association LEAD Scholars Program:** This program was created to enrich the University's diverse student body and academic culture. To be eligible, applicants should have a 3.5 GPA or higher, a 27 or more on the ACT (1220 SAT). The programs award a minimum \$5,000 per year, and are renewable for a total of four years. 2. **METRO BUREAU SCHOLARSHIPS:** To be eligible, students must have a professional objective, or entering a human services profession, (e.g., teaching, medicine, social work, nursing, psychology), or a child-oriented profession. Also, students must intend to enroll at one of the following colleges/universities: Mott Community College, Oakland County Community College, Oakland University, St. Clair County Community College, Wayne County Community College or Wayne State University. The application can be downloaded at www.metrobureau.org. Applications must be submitted by February 26, 2021.

3. **STUDENT – VIEW SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:** The program is offering \$10,000 worth of scholarships to high school seniors who plan to attend a four-year college, community/junior college, or career school. It is quick and easy to apply. There is no ATC score, grade point average, essay, or application fees. Students are asked to simply log on to www.student-view.com and complete a 15-20 minute application survey about colleges in the area. The scholarship deadline is April 22, 2021.

4. **Lawrence Technological University Scholarships:**

There are numerous scholarships available for students who plan on enrolling at Lawrence Tech University. The six freshmen scholarships range from full tuition for four years to \$6,000 annually. Seniors with a GPA of 3.0 or higher are encouraged to take advantage of leading-edge programs in engineering architecture, design, science and applied technology. 5. **THE ABBOTT AND FENNER SCHOLARSHIP:** The scholarship program will be awarding up to \$1,000 to the winner(s) each year. Students will submit an essay on the topic that appears on the scholarship page of the website: <http://www.abbotandfenner.com/scholarships.htm>. Full details are available on the site. The scholarship deadline is June 12, 2021.

6. **MICHIGAN RETAILERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP:** The Association will be awarding 26 \$1,000 to \$1,500 scholarships to high school seniors. The awards are not based on financial need. To be eligible, the students or his/her parent must be employed at a business that is a member of the Michigan Retailers Association (MRA). For more information about the scholarship, please stop by the counseling office. Students can apply at bit.ly/MRAscholarship2021. The deadline for applications to be submitted is April 1, 2021.

7. **Society of Women Engineers Scholarships:** The Detroit Section annually recognizes high school females who have shown exemplary abilities in areas such as leadership, academics and community activities. The section annually awards over \$4,000 in scholarships to exceptional high school senior women who intend to pursue a college degree in engineering. The scholarship application must be filled out and postmarked or emailed by March 1, 2021.
