
## <u>Multi Media</u> <u>Classwork 5-30-19</u> <u>Your Name</u>

## Today's Objectives:

By the end of the class period students should be able to say:

- 1. I CAN explain how to and create a frame by frame animation
- 2. I CAN use the text tool, add keyframes, and sound
- 3. I CAN animate an object using the same layer
- 1. Open up the program Adobe FLASH
- 2. Start a new presentation, change the document size and color
- 3. Save as ### last name, first name-Name
- 4. You are going to create animation using your name. Use the text tool to create a text box with your name in it.



- 5. Add keyframes at different points on layer 1 and change text color, size, and flip it around on each
  keyframe that you create.
  - Keyframes should be added about every 5 to 10 frames for maximum effect.
- 6. You should have at least 20 different keyframes, not frames. That means that your name should flash in at least 20 different ways.
- 7. Save again and publish
- 8. For extra credit, add a layer and import a sound to play while your name flashes.
- 9. Drop off flash player published copy only
