
Procedures Before Class Begins

- 6. Playing with the door knob
- 7. Standing around the door
- 8. Arguing/Fighting
- 9. Misuse of Class Time
- 10. Profanity Any language
- 11. Application of Cosmetics
- 12. Texting, e-mailing, Instant Messaging, Phone usage
- 13. Listening to music

CONSEQUENCES

- 2. Point Deduction
- 3. After School Detention
- 4. Call Home
- 5. Referral
- 6. Parental Conference

TARDIES

- 5 TARDIES = 1 DETENTION
- 10 TARDIES = 2 DETENTIONS

EVERY 5 TARDIES AFTER 10 EQUALS 2 DETENTIONS 15 TARDIES = 2 DETENTIONS 20 TARDIES = 2 DETENTIONS

Tardies result in late bellwork receiving reduced credit and participation deductions for each occurrence.
