## LawCraft - Passing a Law

- 1. What is the party affiliation, personal value, and chamber (House or Senate) that you selected for your character?
- 2. Briefly, which issue did you select to "tackle"? (Ex: "education reform," "reducing pollution," etc.)
- 3. What did you have to add to the bill to get it to pass in your chamber?
- 4. Summarize the process you had to go through to make a bill that both houses (chambers) would agree on.
- 5. Were you able to get your bill signed into law by the President? If so, why? If not, what went wrong?
- 6. When your bill did pass, what was the percentage of support?
- 7. Once you pass your law, reflect on the process:
  - a. In the end, was the "personal value" you selected represented in the law you passed? (Refer to question 1) Explain.
  - b. In your opinion, did the law you passed actually address the original issue? (Refer to question 2) Explain.

Play the game again, this time as a member of the opposite chamber and party. Also, choose a different personal value and issue to tackle.
