

Scharships and Jaying for lege

Scholarships play an increasingly important role in paying for college with 58% of families reporting the student used a scholarship in 2019-20



64% of scholarship recipients used scholarships from the college with an average amount of \$9,671



27% of scholarship recipients used scholarships from the community with an average amount of \$2,204



29% of scholarship recipients used scholarships from the state or local government with an average amount of \$4,698

What are scholarships?

Free money that does not have to be paid back

When to apply for scholarships?

- Based on deadline dates
- Typically a year before entering college
- Every year in college

How to apply for scholarships?

- Requirements and deadline dates vary
- Some may require essays, creative entry, online application

- Financial need
- Community involvement
- Organizational membership
- Sports
- Talent or skill
- ✓ Leadership/school activities
- Ethnicity
- Religious affiliation
- Parent affiliation with work, club, or activity



What to look for in a scholarship search engine?

Look for search engines that offer:

- FREE searches
- Continually validate scholarships
- Calendar listing scholarships by deadline
- Filtering capabilities
 - By name
 - By deadline
 - By award amount
- Rating of scholarships
- Adjustable settings
- Email alerts when new scholarship matches are available
- The ability to save profile information
- Responsive design (mobile-friendly)

Tips for writing a winning scholarship essay

- Start the process early
- Understand the provider's overall mission and purpose
- ✓ Follow the instructions
- Create an outline to organize your thoughts
- Don't be afraid to get personal
- Ask for advice and feedback
- Neatness, spelling and grammar matter proofread more than once
- Be persistent

A good scholarship essay

- Is original and honest
- States clearly why you deserve to win the scholarsh or
- Avoids unnecessary information
- Is inspirational and positive in tone

- Create a lasting impression

Tips for scholarship application success

- Meet deadlines
- •List important accomplishments first
- •Showcase your honors and awards

- Start applying your junior year


You win a scholarship, now what?
