



Communist North

American forces occupying Japan after WWII are sent to defend South Korea. The US and United Nations forces are nearly pushed off the Korean peninsula. The American commander is General Douglass MacArthur.

MacArthur stages a risky, yet successful counterattack at the port of Inchon. North Korean forces are routed and pushed back all the way to the Yalu River, the border of North Korea and communist China.



In November of CHINA 1950, communist China enters the war and pushes the UN and US forces back into South Korea. Sen of The war drags on for several years, finally ending in 1953 very close to the original 1950 borders. The war caused more than two million deaths, including over 50,000 # JAPAN Armistice line Americans. July 27, 1953
