Mini Glossary

foliated: metamorphic rock whose mineral grains are lined up in parallel layers

metamorphic rock: rock that has been changed by heat, pressure, or the presence of hot fluids

nonfoliated: metamorphic rock whose minerals grow and rearrange themselves in a nonlayered texture
