c. $46 + 3 = \underline{49}$ $\overset{40}{\cancel{46}} \quad 6 + 3 = 9$ $40 + 9 = 49$	d. $27 + 50 = \underline{77}$ $\overset{1}{\cancel{20}} \quad 50 + 20 = 70$ $70 + 7 = 77$

$$42 + 1 = 43$$
