IMPORTANT

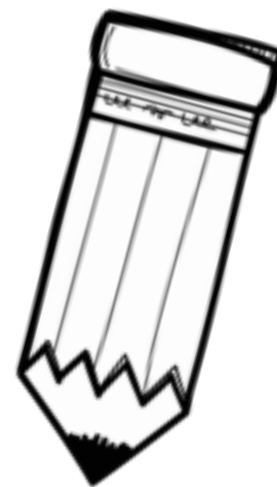
ALL of the 2nd Grade classrooms will be PEANUT FREE. Please check ingredients before sending a snack with your child.

- ☒ Your child will be required to **read** for at least 20 minutes every day at home, including Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- ☒ If your child forgets his/her homework, he/she will bring a note home for you to sign. This will keep you informed of your child's missing assignments.

CONSEQUENCES

Yellow = Warning;

Orange = Time Out & Fill out a "Think About It" form

Red = Complete a "Think About It" form, office referral, and parent contact

Blue = office referral and parent contact
