

The United States Aids Its Allies p. 930

Isolationism [p. 918] = the belief that political ties to other countries should be avoided

Neutrality Acts of 1935 and 1937 = Laws making it illegal to sell arms or lend money to nations at war

Lend-Lease Act = Passed March 1941, the law allowed the President could lend or lease arms and other supplies to any country vital to the United States
