

When To Keep Your Child Home From School

- **Diarrhea** - Two loose or watery stools within **24** hours, even if there are no other signs of illness. Keep child home until no. diarrhea for **24** hours.
- **Fever**- Keep child home with temp **100.5** degrees or higher. Keep child home until fever free for **24** hours without using fever reducing medicine such as Tylenol or Motrin.
- **Vomiting** – Keep child home until no vomiting for **24** hours.
- **Pink Eye**- Keep child home until seen by a doctor and until **24** hours after first dose of medicine, if prescribed.
- **Rash** – Keep child home until seen by a doctor and treated if needed. The school may request a doctor's note to return to school.
