Do you have a favorite tree? Were trees important in a special memory? Do you think it's important to plant and care for trees? How do you think the trees view the world? Students are urged to draw on personal experiences, and remember, creativity and originality count.

So here's how to enter:

- 1. Create an original piece of writing, any type will be accepted, that is 350 words or less
- 2. Entries must be typed, double-spaced, 12 pt. Times New Roman font
- 3. Print and fill out the Creative Writing Contest Entry Form (and be sure to have a parent/quardian sign it)
- 4. Contest runs from January 12 until March 9, 2015
- 5. Mail your entry by March 13, 2015
- 6. Mail both the Entry Form and your creative work to:
