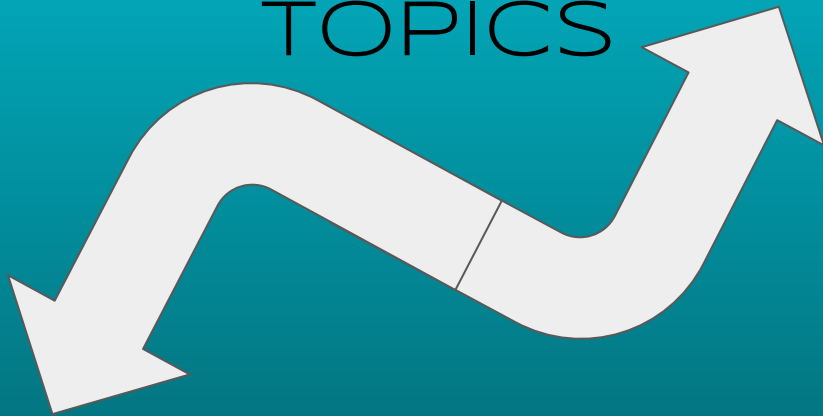

May - August 2017

Board begins discussion on boundary line changes, school of choice and boundary line exemption, and possible need for additional space at high schools

August 2017

Board Study Session

September 2017

Board reviews and identifies possible options to address high school enrollment

October - December 2017

Stakeholder meeting to communicate proposals and gather feedback

January - February 2018

Revisit options, process new information and feedback

March 2018

Board direction and authorization

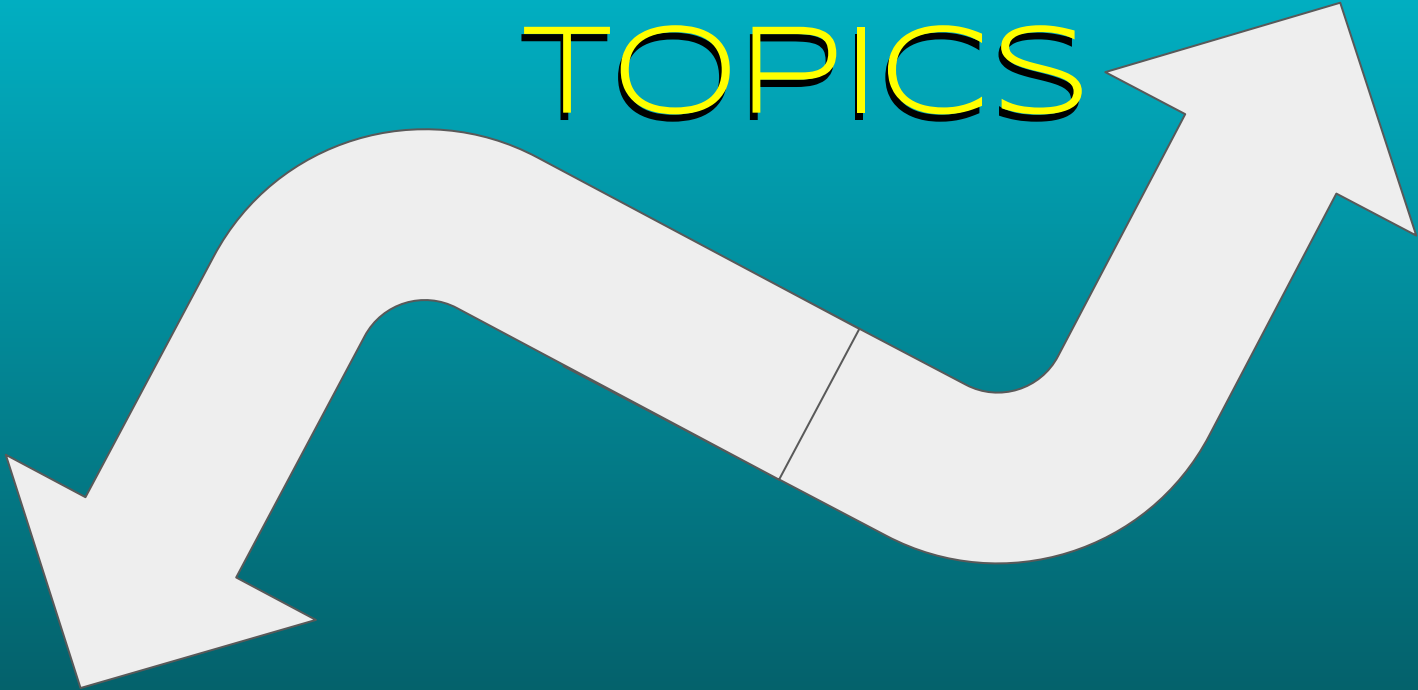

Build A 4th High School

Points To Consider

School Site Size

<u>Type of School</u>	<u>Number of Pupils</u>	<u>Site Size</u>
Elementary	500	10 acres
Middle	1,000	25 acres
High	2,000	25-40 acres

- ❖ Cost: \$70-\$100 million (would require voter approved bond proposal)
 - Average high school size in Dearborn is 280,000 sq.ft.
 - 2014 construction cost \$235 to \$349/sq.ft.
(Since then, price for construction has gone up)
 - Add \$10 million minimum for furnishing/technology/supplies

Build A 4th High School

Points To Consider

- ❖ All current high school boundaries would change
- ❖ 2018-19 projected H.S. enrollment = 6,737 or 1,684*/school
- ❖ Most likely opening for new high school- Fall 2023
- ❖ Average operational costs for a high school are \$2-3 million per year

*Actual number of students in the school would be lower depending on student participation in other off-campus high schools programs.

Create A 9th Grade Academy

Points To Consider

- ❖ Availability of buildings/space in the city
- ❖ Any possible site would require renovations to bring up to Dearborn Public School standards
- ❖ School buildings must meet current codes for fire suppression, ADA compliance, and other health and safety requirements
- ❖ Technology upgrades needed to make compatible with all schools in the District

Cost To Build Additions

Points To Consider

Dearborn High Construction Costs

- 4 classroom addition/cafeteria addition \$3.0m

Edsel Ford High School Construction Costs

- 8 classroom addition/cafeteria addition \$3.3m
- New Fieldhouse/Natatorium Center \$41.8m
 - New Fieldhouse \$7.2m plus soft costs
 - New Natatorium \$9.2m plus soft costs
 - 20+ Classrooms \$10.7m plus soft costs

Michael Berry Construction Costs

- 6 classroom addition/cafeteria addition \$5.5m

Other Thoughts Shared

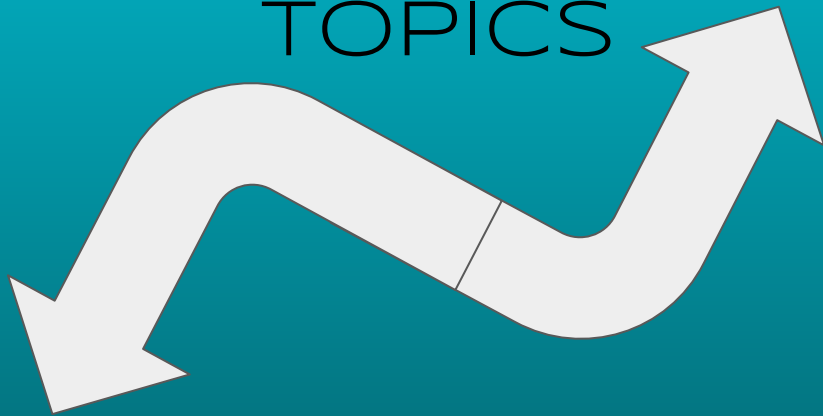
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
