

Welcome to the High School Boundary Proposal Forum

Here is where you will find information regarding the proposed changes to the high school boundaries in the Dearborn Public Schools.

Presentations presented at Board meetings, maps, schedule of community meetings, feedback forms, and other important information will be posted to this site.

Almost thirty consecutive years of enrollment gains have brought Dearborn's numbers from just over 12,000 in the late 1980's to approximately 21,000 in 2017-18 making it the third largest school district in the state.

Through the 1990's the district replaced aging buildings and added new schools. In 2003, a \$150,000 million bond proposal provided for additions at all three high schools and the building of the Berry Career Center. Now, projections show continued increases at the high schools, especially Dearborn High and Fordson which currently enroll 2,077 and 2,790 respectively.



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

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


