

Virtual Learning

Dearborn Public Schools has decided on beginning the school year with virtual learning beginning August 31 - October I. The district will reassess reopening the buildings for in person instruction as we approach October Ist.



Daily Schedule

Each day there will be a combination of live virtual instruction and independent work times. Students can expect live virtual instruction in the morning in ELA and Math between 8:55-II:45. The afternoon session will run from 12:25-3:50 and will include virtual learning labs and independently paced lessons in Science, Social Studies, and electives. All classroom instruction will take place through our new Schoology Platform and Zoom.
