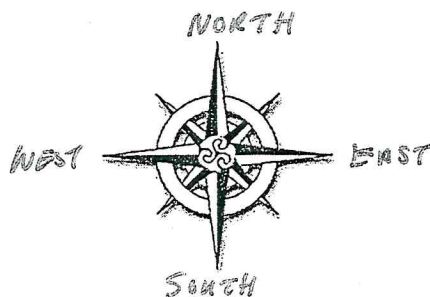


06. On a compass rose label all four of the cardinal directions.



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07. What is the difference between longitude and latitude? And how is this related to meridians and parallels?

- LINES OF LATITUDE OR PARALLELS RUN EAST & WEST (RIGHT TO LEFT) AROUND THE WORLD. (NEVER INTERSECT)
- LINES OF LONGITUDE OR MERIDIANS RUN NORTH & SOUTH (UP & DOWN) AROUND THE WORLD (INTERSECT OR CROSS AT THE POLES)

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08. What is the difference between the equator and the prime meridian?

THE EQUATOR IS A LINE OF LATITUDE CIRCLES THE EARTH MIDWAY BETWEEN THE NORTH & SOUTH POLES.

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THE PRIME MERIDIAN WHICH RUNS THROUGH GREENWICH, ENGLAND AND IS A LINE OF LONGITUDE CONNECTING NORTH POLE TO THE SOUTH POLE.

09. What is the difference between absolute location and relative location?

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ABSOLUTE LOCATION - IS THE PRECISE POINT WHERE A PLACE IS LOCATED ON EARTH.

RELATIVE LOCATION - IS WHERE A PLACE IS LOCATED IN RELATION TO ANOTHER PLACE.

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11. What is the difference between revolution and rotation? How many days are in a year and how many hours in a full day?

REVOLUTION = (365 $\frac{1}{4}$ DAYS) EARTH MOVES AROUND THE SUN IN A NEARLY CIRCULAR PATH CALLED AN ORBIT.
