

- LINES OF LATITUDE OR PARALLELS RUN EAST & WEST (RIGHT TO LEFT) AROUND THE WORLD. (NEVER INTERSECT)
- LINES OF LONGITUDE OR MERIDIANS) RUN NORTH & SOUTH (UP & DOWN) AROUND THE WORLD (INTERSECT OR CROSS AT THE POLES)

THE EQUATOR IS A LINE OF LATITUDE CIRCLES THE EARTH MIDWAY BETWEEN THE NORTH & SOUTH POLES.
