From 1979 - 2000 Saddam Hussein controlled Iraq's oil income. He spent most of Iraq's money on building an army, buying weapons, + fighting. Very little \$ was spent for ordinary people.

26. Why was Kuwait so important to Iraq and Saddam Hussein? SADAM invaded Kuwait

Kuwait is a tiny country, but it holds about 10% of the oil reserves. Saddam ordered his military to invade Kuwait. This gave him control of Kuwait's oil fields. Others fear he may or take over more.

29. Explain the Persian Gulf War.

The Persian Gulf War (Aug 2, 1990 - Feb 28, 1991) codenamed Operation Desert Shield was a coalition of 35 nations. This coalition led by the U.S. went to war to drive Iraqi forces out of Kuwait. Kuwait was freed from Iraqi control, but not before Iraqi soldiers set 730 oil wells on fire. This was also called Operation Desert Storm in its combat phase.
